

Ukrainian Iron and Steel Works in January-April 2007

Alchevsk steel mill ups roll output 4.2% in 4 mths

Alchevsk Iron & Steel Works, a member of the Industrial Union of Donbas (IUD) group, increased finished roll output tentatively 4.2% year-on-year in January-April to 1.092 million tonnes, including 281,000 tonnes in April. The mill increased crude steel production 1% year-on-year in the four months to 1.242 million tonnes. Pig iron production rose 4.8% to 963,000 tonnes and sinter output rose 1.1% to 1.689 million tonnes. Finished roll production at Alchevsk grew 13.2% to 3.261 million tonnes in 2006.

Azovstal ups roll output 14.6% in 4 mths

Azovstal steel mill raised finished roll production 14.6% year-on-year in January-April to 1.79 million tonnes, including 474,000 tonnes in April. Crude steel production rose 17.2% to 2.05 million tonnes in the four months and pig iron was up 22.5% to 1.785 million tonnes, however sinter fell 2.3% to 628,000 tonnes.

Dniprovsky mill ups roll output 6.6% in 4 mths

Dniprovsky Dzerzhinsky Metallurgical Combine (DMK) raised finished roll output 6.6% year-on-year in January-April to 1.09 million tonnes, including 275,000 tonnes in April. Crude steel production grew 11.1% to 1.27 million tonnes, pig iron was up 12.8% to 1.13 million tonnes and sinter output rose 6.9% to 1.87 million tonnes. Finished roll production grew 8.8% to 3.165 million tonnes in 2006.

Donetsk steel mill boosts roll output 16% in 4 mths

Donetsk Metallurgical Plant (DMZ) raised finished roll output tentatively 15.6% year-on-year in January-April to 252,000 tonnes, including 65,000 tonnes in April. Crude steel output rose 25% to 340,000 tonnes and pig iron was up 29.1% to 302,000 tonnes.

Ilyich steel mill ups roll output 4.9% in 4 mths

Ilyich Iron and Steel Works of Mariupol (MMK) raised finished roll production 4.9% year-on-year to 1.87 million tonnes in January-April, including 450,000 tonnes in April. Crude steel production was up 6.1% to 2.38 million tonnes and pig iron rose 8.3% to 1.88 million tonnes. Sinter production grew 4.4% to 3.89 million tonnes and steel pipe output increased 11.3% to 36,300 tonnes. Ilyich aims to increase crude steel production 1.8% to 7.1 million tonnes this year. OJSC Ilyich Iron & Steel Works of Mariupol is one of Ukraine's three biggest steel mills and partner of Metal-Forum of Ukraine.

ISTIL sees 45.8% rise in rolled stock output in 4 months of 2007

Donetsk mini steel mill ISTIL (Ukraine) boosted the production of ready-made rolled stock by 45.8% from January to April 2007 year-over-year, to 309,000 tonnes, while the production of steel increased by 39.2%, to 323,000 tonnes. In April alone, the mill produced 84,000 tonnes of rolled stock and 89,000 tonnes of steel.

Mittal Steel Kryviy Rih boosts roll output 11.3% in 4 months

Mittal Steel Kryviy Rih (formerly Kryvorizhstal) boosted finished roll production 11.3% year-on-year in January-April to 2.39 million tonnes. Pig iron production grew 15.8% to 2.47 million tonnes, sinter rose 11.7% to 4.05 million tonnes and crude steel rose 20.5% to 2.77 million tonnes. Coke production grew 14.2% to 1.03 million tonnes and iron ore concentrate production grew 16.1% to 2.73 million tonnes. In April alone, the mill produced 578,000 tonnes of finished roll, 708,000 tonnes of crude steel, 617,000 tonnes of pig iron and 988,000 million tonnes of sinter. Mittal Steel Kryviy Rih controls up to 20% of Ukraine's steel market. Ukraine's biggest steel mill is partner of Metal-Forum of Ukraine.

Yenakiyive steel works ups roll output 12.8% in 4 mths

Yenakiyive Metallurgical Plant raised finished roll output 12.8% year-on-year in January-April to 905,000 tonnes, including 230,000 tonnes in April. The company saw crude steel output rise 8.4% to 895,000 tonnes and pig iron production grow 7.7% to 768,000 tonnes in the four months.

Zaporizhstal ups roll output 2.3% in 4 months

Zaporizhstal increased production of finished roll by 2.3% year-on-year in the first four months of 2007 to 1.23 million 920,000 tonnes, including 310,000 tonnes in April. Production in the four months was up 3% to 1.48 million tonnes of crude steel, 2.3% to 1.18 million tonnes of pig iron and 3% to 1.85 million tonnes of sinter. Zaporizhstal is one of the largest industrial enterprises in Ukraine and partner of Metal-Forum of Ukraine.
