

Ukrainian Iron and Steel Works in January-March 2007

Alchevsk Iron & Steel Works ups roll output 6.5% in Q1

Alchevsk Iron & Steel Works, a member of the Industrial Union of Donbas (IUD) group, increased finished roll output tentatively 6.5% year-on-year in January-March to 807,000 tonnes, including 281,000 tonnes in March. The mill increased crude steel production 3.4% year-on-year in the three months to 942,000 tonnes. Pig iron production fell 1.6% to 733,000 tonnes, but sinter output rose 1.8% to 1.279 million tonnes.

Azovstal ups roll output 14.4% in Q1

The Azovstal steel mill in Ukraine's Donetsk region raised finished roll production 14.4% year-on-year in January-March to 1.35 million tonnes, including 519,000 tonnes in March. Crude steel production rose 16.1% to 1.54 million tonnes in the three months and pig iron was up 19.7% to 1.33 million tonnes, however sinter fell 4.6% to 476,000 tonnes.

Dniprospetsstal boosts roll output 29% in Q1

The Interpipe corporation's Dniprospetsstal steel works in Zaporizhia, Ukraine, produced 88,000 tonnes of finished roll in January-March, up 29.4% year-on-year, including 35,000 tonnes in March. Crude steel production rose 13.3% year-on-year to 136,000 tonnes.

Dniprovsky Mill ups roll output 8.7% in Q1

Industrial Union of Donbas or IUD's Dniprovsky Dzerzhinsky Metallurgical Combine (DMK) raised finished roll output 8.7% year-on-year in January-March to 837,000 tonnes, including 300,000 tonnes in March. The production in the three months grew 12.3% to 962,000 tonnes of crude steel, 12.8% to 855,000 tonnes of pig iron and 7% to 1.397 million tonnes of sinter.

Donetsk Steel Mill boosts roll output 20% in Q1

Donetsk Metallurgical Plant (DMZ) raised finished roll output tentatively 19.9% year-on-year in January-March to 187,000 tonnes, including 66,000 tonnes in March. Crude steel output rose 28.6% to 252,000 tonnes and pig iron was up 6.7% to 190,000 tonnes. The plant produces 290 types of sections, bars, shaped steel, steel plate and ship-building steel.

Ilyich Iron & Steel Works boosts roll output 8% in Q1

Ilich Metallurgical Combine of Mariupol (MMK) raised finished roll production 8.1% year-on-year to 1.42 million tonnes in January-March, including 501,000 tonnes in March. Crude steel production was up 9.6% to 1.79 million tonnes and pig iron rose 11.5% to 1.42 million tonnes. Sinter production rose 1.5% to 2.83 million tonnes and steel pipe output rose 10.9% to 25,400 tonnes. OJSC Ilyich Iron & Steel Works of Mariupol is one of Ukraine's three biggest steel mills and partner of Metal-Forum of Ukraine.

ISTIL boosts roll output 64.5% in Q1

The ISTIL Mini Steel mill raised production of finished roll 64.5% year-on-year in January-March to 232,000 tonnes, including 88,000 tonnes in March. Crude steel production grew 56.4% to 233,000 tonnes in the three months, including 91,000 tonnes in March. Mini steel mill ISTIL is one of the most advanced steel mills in Ukraine and partner of Metal-Forum of Ukraine.

Makiyivka Metallurgical Plant boosts pig iron output 59% in Q1

Makiyivka Metallurgical Plant (MMZ) increased production of pig iron by 59% year-on-year to 459,000 tonnes in January-March, including 165,000 tonnes in March. Crude steel production was up 19.5% to 431,000 tonnes, finished roll output rose 19% to 231,000 tonnes in the three months.

Mittal Steel Kryviy Rih boosts roll output 15% in Q1

Mittal Steel Kryviy Rih (formerly Kryvorizhstal) boosted finished roll production 14.8% year-on-year in January-March to 1.795 million tonnes. Pig iron production grew 19.6% to 1.849 million tonnes, sinter rose 11.7% to 2.995 million tonnes and crude steel rose 22.5% to 2.07 million tonnes. Coke production grew 15.8% to 768,000 tonnes and iron ore concentrate production grew 17.9% to 2.06 million tonnes, however crude ore production fell 1.1% to 473,000 tonnes. Mittal Steel Kryviy Rih is Ukraine's biggest steel mill and the partner of Metal-Forum of Ukraine.

Petrovsky Steel Mill ups roll production 15% in Q1

The Petrovsky Metallurgical Plant (DMZ) raised finished roll production 15.1% year-on-year in January-March to 344,000 tonnes, including 107,000 tonnes in March. Crude steel production rose by 5.1% to 333,000 tonnes and pig iron rose 9.6% to 377,000 tonnes in the three months.

Yenakiyev Steel Works ups roll output 17.4% in Q1

The Metinvest group's Yenakiyev Metallurgical Plant raised finished roll output 17.4% year-on-year in January-March to 710,000 tonnes, including 220,000 tonnes in March. The company saw crude steel output rise 6.4% to 664,000 tonnes and pig iron production grow 5.9% to 570,000 tonnes in the three months.

Zaporizhstal ups roll output 2% in Q1

Zaporizhstal increased production of finished roll by 1.9% year-on-year in the first three months of 2007, to 920,000 tonnes, including 317,000 tonnes in March. Production was also up 2.2% to 1.094 million tonnes of crude steel, 0.5% to 868,000 tonnes of pig iron and 5% to 1.419 million tonnes of sinter. Zaporizhstal exports around 70% of its steel to more than 70 countries. Zaporizhstal Integrated Iron & Steel Works is one of the largest industrial enterprises of Ukraine and the main partner of Metal-Forum of Ukraine.
